

Brief Description*

The breed recognized in Australia and European FCI countries as the Jack Russell Terrier, in the US as the Russell Terrier.

AKC Foundation Stock Service Recorded

History: Originated in England in the 1800's due to the efforts of the Reverend John Russell. Imported into Australia, where the breed was developed & first gained Kennel club recognition.

Height: 10 to 12 inches

Weight: 11 to 13 pounds

Coat types:

Smooth -short, thick, hard

Broken -long & short hairs mixed, usually with face furnishings, good undercoat

Rough -long hair, hard, not woolly, lies flat to the body

Colors: At least 51% white, with tan, black and any combinations of those colors only.

Overall body shape: **rectangular** with back length marginally longer than tall. Brisket located midway between withers and ground

Legs: 1/2 of overall height, straight

Head & Ears: Skull flat, the length from the stop to the nose should be slightly shorter than from the stop to the occiput. Head planes are parallel. Ears are small v-shaped and folded over.
